# Regarding the collection of fee for establishing and sending an e-mail of containers' weights

#### **Chairman of the Alexandria Port**

Following perusal of General Authorities' Law No.61 for the year 1963;

Law No.6 for the year 1967 regarding the establishment of the General Authority for Alexandria Port;

Law No.53 for the year 1973 regarding the state budget and the general approvals attached thereto;

Law No.8 for the year 1990 regarding the issuance of the Maritime Trade Law;

The Presidential decree No.3293 for the year 1966 setting the purviews and responsibilities of the General Authority for Alexandria Port;

The Presidential Decree No.110 for the year 2000 regarding granting the chairmen of port authorities the administrative supervisory authorities over all department operating inside the ports;

The Presidential Decree No.57 for the year 2002 regulating the Ministry of Transport;

The Decree of the Minister of Transport No.488 for the year 2015 regarding the fees for the services provided to vessels at Egyptian ports, the usage fee of the fixed and floating facilities and constructions of the Port Authorities and the Egyptian Authority for Maritime Safety (EAMS) and the fee for the electronic services provided by the Port Authorities;

The memo of the General Authority for Alexandria Port No.32 for the year 2019 related to the approval of collecting a fee against taking out a Verified Gross Mass (VGM) card for loaded trucks with outbound containers, to be added to the cashier invoice of outbound trucks;



The decision of the board of directors of the General Authority for Alexandria Port, in its fifth hearing held on 17/10/2019, as approved by the Minister of Transport on 9/11/2019, to approve the collection of the fee of a VGM card and the cost of establishing e-mails for loaded and outbound containers by the shipper amounting to EGP 100 / 20" container and EGP 200 / 40" container;

What we deemed as beneficial for business;

#### **DECIDED:**

## (Article One)

Fee for the issuance of a VGM card and establishment and sending an e-mail for loaded and outbound containers shall be collected from the shipper as follows:

EGP 100 (One hundred Egyptian Pounds) / 20"container EGP 200 (Two hundred Egyptian Pounds) / 40"container

## (Article Two)

The aforementioned amount in the previous article shall be added to the exiting truck's invoice from the port.

## (Article Three)

The competent authorities shall implement this decree accordingly.

## (Article Four)

This decree is to be published in the Egyptian Gazette and shall come into force from the next day of its publication.
