Of the Supreme Committee for the Management of Epidemics and Health Pandemics No.3 for year 2022

The Supreme Committee for the Management of Epidemics and Health Pandemics

Following the perusal of the constitution;

The Law No. 152 for the year 2021 regarding the procedures to face epidemics and health pandemics;

The decree of the Cabinet Minister No.3400 for the year 2021 regarding the necessary measures against the coronavirus;

The decision of the Supreme Committee for the Management of Epidemics and Health Pandemics No.1 for year 2021;

The decision of the Supreme Committee for the Management of Epidemics and Health Pandemics No.2 for the year 2022;

Following the approval of the Supreme Committee for the Management of Epidemics and Health Pandemics;

Decided: (Article One)

All restrictions stipulated on the entry of Egyptians or foreigners into the Arab Republic of Egypt and mentioned in Article Seven of the decision of the Supreme Committee for the Management of Epidemics and Health Pandemics No.1 for year 2021 shall be cancelled.

(Article Two)

Without prejudice to the provision of the previous article, the remaining measures stipulated in the decisions of the Supreme Committee for the Management of Epidemics and Health Pandemics No.1 for year 2021 and No.2 for the year 2022 shall remain in force where the measures mentioned therein and, in these decisions, shall be subject to the discretion of the situation.

(Article Three)

This decision shall be published in the Egyptian Gazette and shall come into force as of the next day of its publication.
