Instructions of the Director General of the Customs Authority No. (65) for the year 2022

Following the directives of the Director General No. (60) for the year 2022, and in light of the directions of the Minister of Finance about the facilitation of customs procedures for customers of the Tax Authority.

It shall be considered that the renewal of the duration of depositing cargoes at temporary warehouses at ports which is stipulated to be two months pursuant to Article (137) of the Executive Regulations of the Customs Law shall be as follows:

- 1- The renewal period for foodstuffs shall not exceed two months.
- 2- The renewal period for the remaining cargoes shall not exceed four months. This is in addition to the stipulated two months in the abovementioned Article No. 137.

These instructions shall prevail for a period of six months as of date where the decision shall be reconsidered afterwards, in all cases cargoes subject to damage or shortage deposited at the warehouses may not be kept for a duration exceeding the period permitted for its condition.

These instructions shall be implemented thoroughly with the permitted periods to avoid being held liable.
