

**Decree of the Minister of Finance
No. 460 for the year 2022**

Minister of Finance:

- Following the perusal of the Customs Law promulgated by Law No.207 for the year 2020;
- The Executive Regulations of the Customs Law promulgated by the Decree of the Minister of Finance No.430 for the year 2021;
- And for the greater good.

**Decided:
(Article One)**

Any administration of the concerned Customs Administration shall not be allowed to refer any of the cargoes located at ports or temporary warehouses including perishable cargoes to the General Administrations to be considered as abandoned or take any sale procedures without obtaining the approval of the Minister of Finance based on the submitted memorandum by the Director General of the Customs Authority to be prepared by the competent administration. This memorandum shall include a declaration of the cargo condition and its date of expiry, if found.

(Article Two)

This decree shall be published in the Egyptian Gazette and shall come into force as of the day of its publication.
