## Instructions of the Director General of the Customs Authority No. (5) for the year 2023

With reference to the decision of the Minister of Finance No.460 for the year 2022 issued regarding that no administration of the concerned Customs Administration shall be allowed to refer any of the cargoes located at ports or temporary warehouses including perishable cargoes or those subject to decrease to the General Administrations of abandoned cargoes or to take any sale procedures without obtaining the approval of the Minister of Finance based on the submitted memorandum by the Director General of the Customs Authority to be prepared by the competent administration. This memorandum shall include a declaration of the cargo condition and its date of expiry, if found.

In addition to the instructions of the Customs Authority No. 69 for the year 2022 in that respect.

In execution of the approval of the Minister of Finance on the submitted memoranda by the Customs Authority No.245/g/2023 and 357/g/2023.

## The following shall be considered:

Instructions of the Director General of the Customs Authority No. 69 for the year 2022 shall be extended until 1/4/2023 with the exception of cargoes that the devolvement of their ownership to the Customs Authority has been verified as a result of settlement or confiscation through a judicial order or waiver or that the conditions in its regard have been met pursuant to the provision of Article 70 of the Customs Law No.207 for the year 2020.

These instructions shall be implemented thoroughly to avoid being held liable.
