## Instructions of the Director General of the Customs Authority No. (78) for the year 2022

In light of the follow up of the execution of the stipulated procedures of accepting the waived cargoes in favor of the Customs Authority and in execution of the provisions of the Customs Law promulgated by Law No.207 for the year 2020 and its executive regulations;

The following shall be considered:

- 1- The competent Customs Administrations shall commit not to accept the waiver of cargoes that are banned from entering the Country or rejected by the Regulatory Authorities.
- 2- The concerned parties shall be alerted to promptly re-export these cargoes or destroy same at their own expense pursuant to what is decided by the competent Regulatory Authorities unless these cargoes are not subject to confiscation in a Customs case or a judicial decision has been issued in their regard.

These instructions shall be implemented thoroughly to avoid being held liable.
