

**PROCEDURES CIRCULAR
NO. (2) FOR THE YEAR 2023**

With reference to:

- The Customs Law No. 207 for the year 2020
- The Executive Regulations of the Customs Law promulgated by Ministerial decree No. 430 for the year 2021.
- Procedures Circular No.3 for the year 2022.
- The letter of the Head of the Central Administration of the affairs of the Director General office No.264/I dated 10/1/2023 attached thereto the minutes of the meeting of the Egyptian-Jordanian joint technical committee for inland transport held in Cairo during the period of 27-28/12/2022 which includes the continuation of operation with the mechanism of entry of Jordanian and Egyptian buses between the countries that have been granted operation permit to transfer passengers from the Ministries of Transport of each Country.

The following shall be considered:

- First:** The continuation of operation with the mechanism of entry of Jordanian and Egyptian trucks and reefers between both countries for a duration of two years that expire on 31/12/2024 to enter loaded or empty to the lands of both countries and return empty or loaded through the same route (Aqaba – Nuweiba). Trucks and reefers will not be allowed to practice any haulage operations in the lands of either country. Furthermore, trucks and reefers shall not be allowed to change their exit route or load for a third party except after obtaining authorization from the competent authorities of both parties pursuant to the provisions of the haulage convention between both countries.
- Second:** The continuation of operation with the mechanism of entry of Jordanian and Egyptian buses between the countries that have been granted operation permit to transfer passengers from the Ministries of Transport of each Country pursuant to what has been previously enforced up till 31/12/2024 provided that buses check in with the customs (Nuweiba Customs) upon entry and exit for the purposes of registration.
- Third:** The necessity of commitment of the Jordanian truck drivers to carry their driving licenses, trucks licenses, and valid passports that have not expired pursuant to what has been stated in the articles of the convention upon arrival at Egyptian lands or transit through its lands.

The above has been sent for your kind knowledge and to be thoroughly implemented.
